**DECLARATION OF RUSSEL R. HARVILLE IN SUPPORT OF ANHEUSER-BUSCH
COMPANIES, LLC'S OPPOSITION TO MILLERCOORS, LLC'S MOTION FOR A
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

1. My name is Russell R. Harville. I am currently the Vice President, Raw Materials, Auxiliaries and Utilities Procurement. I have been with the Anheuser-Busch for over 20 years. I have been in my current position for approximately 7 years. My responsibilities include sourcing the items that it takes to make beer, including ingredients, energy and water. My current scope includes all of the US and Canada, plus barley and malt for Mexico.

2. In my experience, rice is a more expensive ingredient than ingredients made from corn, including both corn grits and corn syrup/dextrose. For the past five years, rice has been approximately fifty cents (\$0.50) more expensive on average than corn grits and corn syrup/dextrose per pound. Anheuser-Busch purchases more than 21.6 million bushels of rice per year.
